The band for the show includes drummer 'Stuart Turner' (who has worked with Jamie since 2001), keyboard player 'Nick Keys' (who has worked with the likes of Rick Wakeman & Chesney Hawkes) and old school friend and bassist, 'Kevin Joyce'.

Jamie is a talented singer guitarist and band leader born in Reading. He has enjoyed touring all over the world singing & performing since he was ten years old and is also a Gold Selling songwriter.

He has performed alongside and worked with artists such as T'pau, Tony Hadley, East 17, Toyah, Chesney Hawkes, M People, Doctor & the Medics, Nick Kershaw, Jason Donovan, Musical Youth, Betty Boo, Rick Parfitt, Bad Manners and many more.

Charity is something Jamie is often involved in and played for Children in Need which was featured on BBC1 for his debut TV performance in 2004.

In May 2005 helped raise £20,000 for The Royal Marsden Cancer Campaign. 2007 Jamie's band was involved in 'The Chesney Hawkes Xmas Cracker' event raising £25,000 for The White Lodge Centre.
